## Consent to use school inhaler and auto-injector (epipen) in an emergency

To support the health and safety of students with asthma or severe allergies, Maiden Erlegh School in Reading holds a small supply of emergency inhalers and auto-injectors (e.g. EpiPens) for use in the event of a medical emergency.

**We ask that parents/carers provide the school with a spare inhaler and/or auto-injector for their child, clearly labelled with their name. These will be stored securely and used as the first line of response.**

In the event that a student's personal device is not available or accessible, the school may use an emergency inhaler or auto-injector, provided that parental consent has been given.

Emergency inhalers are sterilised after each use.

Emergency auto-injectors are single-use only, and if used, we will request that parents provide a replacement for the school's emergency supply.
